WMB and an army of over 100 volunteers built the largest building 48' x 92' we've ever built in a third world country. 45 yards of cement for the floor alone was mixed w/ shovels and lots of muscle power by a lot of hard working young people. Our BIG THANKS to Highland Meadows Christian Church & Bill Groom, Colleyville, TX; Eureka Springs, AR Christian Church & Philip Wilson; Ozark Christian College & Dr. Terry Bowland, Joplin, MO; Christview Christian Church & Jason Cannady, Tulsa, OK; Mark & Larry + Crew from Lawton, OK. We held a 2 week revival in Allende and a week revival in Nava, a village close to Allende. There were 3 baptisms in the baptistry before the building was complete.

208 Ormoix, Leyte, Philippine UPDATE

We had only 5 Americans, but an additional 33 Filipino Volunteers from churches that we have helped over the years to show up and build a beautiful 30 x 60 chapel in Tambulid, a suburb of Ormoix, Leyte. We had 13 baptisms on the dedication night with 24 rededications. We had an additional 6 baptisms and 2 more young men to dedicate their lives to Full Time Christian Service who will be going to Bible College (we need sponsors). The building was fully plastered and painted with glass in the windows and beautiful carved doors. This was one of our nicer completions. Thanks to all who made this possible, from the prayer warriors on down.
