We just received final approval on April 1, 2011 that we will be able to build two Chapels at the Dick Conner Correctional Center, 129 Conner Rd, Hominy, OK 74035-0220. World Mission Builders will be working September 16-30. We will be building two chapels, one inside the fence and one outside the fence.



There will be 2 tents with an outside kitchen. RV hook ups are available. Three meals a day provided. Housing will be available in homes nearby.

This will be a very exciting and a very rewarding project. Since the background checks are only good for a year, we all will be required to fill out a new DOC security form. Please communicate with us as to whether you plan to help on this project and we'll get that form to you.

Our biggest challenge will be to raise \$100,000.00 in cash before this project starts. We have lots of donated goods and services but not the cash. Please make this an urgent matter of prayer that God will open up the windows of heaven and bless this project.
